Competition is open to amateur and hobby artist only.

Entries from Veterans, emergency services and members of the armed forces community. I.e. families.

All works to have been completed in the past six months and must be the artists original work. No copies.

No more than one entry per category.

No original pieces to be sent, we are unable to return.

Files must be submitted by email to, stevebutterworth@vic.org.uk and sent in jpeg format only.

There will be one winner and one runner up from each category.

Closing date will be 1100 on the 11th November.

By submitting an entry to the competition, you give VIC : a, permission for your entry to be published on social media and grant VIC a non-exclusive, royalty free, worldwide licence to re-publish your competition entry in electronic format and hard copy, for purposes connected with the competition; and b, the right to use your name, age and town or City of residence for the sole purpose of identifying you as the author of your entry.

The judge's decision is final.

The winners and runners up will be announced on Facebook and our website www.veteransincommunities.org on Friday 18th. December 2020.
